Angra Dos Reis

Angra dos Reis is one of Brazil's most dazzling and breathtaking destinations. Composed of more than three hundred islands and over two thousand beaches, Angra dos Reis is the tropical vacation destination of any discerning travelers' fantasies.

The city's center is reminiscent of smaller colonial cities and boasts amazing historical monuments, churches and architecture. Ilha Grande, the largest island of the 365, serves as the main attraction and was used as the colonial center for pirates who originally settled there. Ocean tours and activities are widely available and provide the opportunity to visit the different islands and beaches as well as enjoy the exclusivity of their sandy shores.

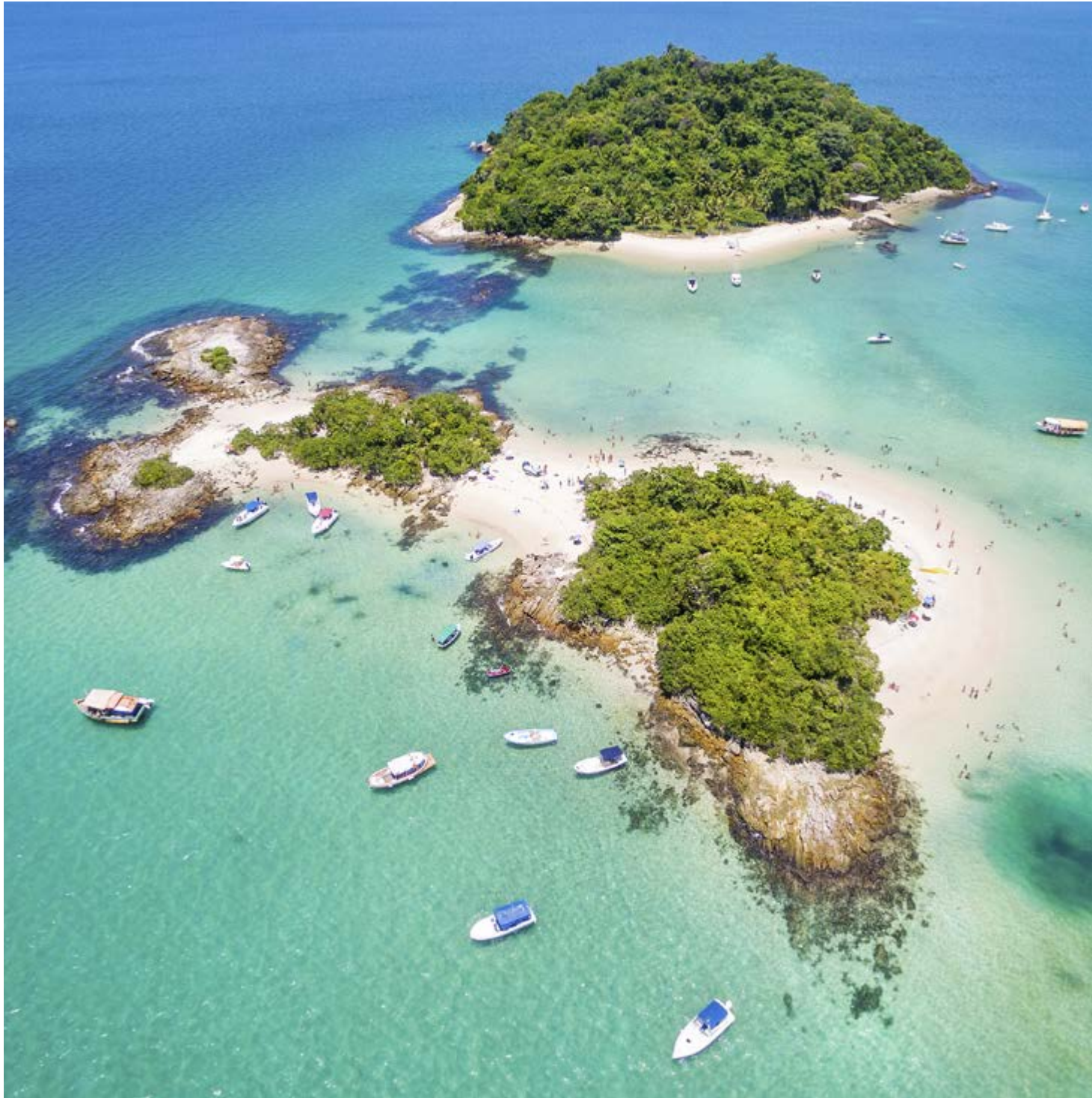

Private Yacht Tour to Ilha Grande

A tour through Angra must undoubtedly begin at the sea. Diving into this beautiful sea is simply irresistible. With a large amount of shipwrecks and an abundant marine life, the Angra Bay is one of the best diving spots of the southeastern coast, even for rookies. A traditional maritime procession held on the first day of the year is one of the biggest events in the city.

Ilha Grande, the biggest of the isles, is also the most famous: there are 86 beaches spread out throughout its 190 square kilometers.



Paraty

Originally settled by the Portuguese in the 1660s, Paraty has maintained a colonial feel with its original architecture and a virtually unchanged culture. The city originally served as an exportation site for gold sent to Portugal and possesses exquisite churches, cobble stone streets and delicious restaurants.

Cars are not permitted within the historical section of the city, which adds to the charm and allure of this site. Paraty hosts an array of cultural and musical festivals and has a vast and interesting colonial history, as well as the nearby beaches and forests.

Casa Turquesa

Located in front of the pier in the historical center of Paraty, it offers nine cozy and comfortable suites with views of the landscapes of Paraty from the windows and balconies. The bay, the city's famous rooftops, the mountains and the dome of the Church of Santa Rita - the oldest religious building in the city - are the scenes that surround the Pousada. Every room has air conditioning, LCD TVs, a ceiling fan, a safe, a mini-bar, a telephone and a computer input. Casa Turquesa recreates the façade of an old building from the eighteenth century, destroyed by fire thirty years ago. The restoration of the site was done with great care and concern to preserve the colonial architecture, as well as to offer the best for its visitors.
