



On Both Sides of the Falls

Your trip begins at the Iguaçu National Park on the Brazilian side with a drive through the lush vegetation en route to the falls. Take a stroll on the trail that descends down the canyon, offering panoramic views of more than 240 falls. Then, hop on a glass elevator, for an exquisite view from the upper deck. Afterwards, cross the Tancredo Neves catwalk, towards the Argentine side. Here, a small train takes you through the park, making two stops. Follow the pathways to the top of the waterfalls, which provide spectacular views of the falls set among the abundant nature filled with orchids, birds and other wildlife. The highlight of the tour is a visit to the platform at the very brink of the 'Devil's Throat' waterfall, the largest in the park.

Helicopter Tour Over Iguassu

Experience a unique view of the waterfalls by helicopter. This exciting 10-minute tour offers a rare opportunity to observe the picturesque landscape and the spectacular scenery of the Iguaçu National Park from above. You will have an unrivalled view of the Três Fronteiras (the meeting point of the borders between Argentina, Brazil and Paraguay) and the Itaipú Dam and reservoir.

Backstage at the Birds' Park

Parque das Aves is an internationally-recognized rescue and conservation center for birds, located in the middle of the rich and exuberant Atlantic Rainforest, a neighbor of Iguassu National Park. The Backstage Experience is an exclusive opportunity to have a look behind the scenes during a one and a half hour tour. Gain access to restricted areas and have privileged contact with selected birds, including feeding toucans and other species, as well as the opportunity to learn more about the conservation and rescue programs at the park.
