ITINERARY

1 Arrive in Nairobi

Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, meet your guardian angel who will transfer you to Aman House, your home for the next two nights.

2 Nairobi

Today, explore Nairobi. Feed the giraffes at the Giraffe Centre followed by a trip into the forest to experience our exclusive Insider Access Activity: Forest Folk Stories with lunch. In the afternoon you will have a private visit with the elephants at the David Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage.

Take a short walk beneath the canopy of the Ololua Forest – a dry tropical forest that once would have covered most of this part of Nairobi. As you near the clearing you will hear drums in the distance and a traditional song of welcome calls you in. From the shadows your storyteller appears, their stories seem to weave a spell around you which intermingles with the sounds of the forest. They will pull you into the magic of the tales that have been handed down from generation to generation; stories of great warriors and tricky tortoises that will leave you captivated.

3 Masai Mara National Reserve

Board your private charter to the Masai Mara, on arrival you will be met by the guides from Amani House and enjoy a game drive into the house.

Located on the northern edge of the Masai Mara, on a private conservancy famous for its rewilding project, sits the stunning Amani House. The perfect location for a group of friends or family travelling together with seven bedrooms, which includes one bunk room with four queen sized bunk beds, seven double rooms and one twin room, each with their own private bathrooms. The house overlooks a beautiful lawn complete with a swimming pool and hot tub and out over the conservancy, with the dramatic hills in the distance. Days are planned as per your preference – set out on game drives in the conservancy, enjoy al fresco meals under the pergola, fire up the competitive spirits with a game of basketball or tennis on the court or simply lie by the pool, book in hand.

4 & 5 Masai Mara National Reserve

Spend the next two days exploring the Enonkishu Conservancy on the edge of the Masai Mara. The conservancy has a high density of lions and ensures you receive the most exclusive game viewing experience.





Game viewing is never dull in the Mara, and patience is often rewarded with unique sightings: a pride of lion stalking their prey; a solitary leopard retrieving its kill from the high branches of an acacia tree; male wildebeest sparring to attract females into their harem; or even a herd of elephant protecting their young from opportunistic predators. The annual wildebeest migration traditionally is present in the Mara from July-September and at this time nature's dramas unfold before your very eyes at every turn.

6 Fly to Borana Conservancy, Laikipia

After a leisurely breakfast drive to the airstrip for your private charter flight to Borana Conservancy in Laikipia. On arrival you will be met by the Lengishu guides and enjoy a game drive back to the house.

Lengishu is an exclusive-use house located on a hillside with beautiful views over the vast landscape in Borana Conservancy in Laikipia. Borana places high emphasis on conservation and together with neighbouring Lewa, has the highest population of black rhino and Grevy's zebra in Kenya. Built entirely with local material, Lengishu comprises of six bright and spacious rooms - a master bedroom and Room 1 that stands away from the main house while two family cottages are situated on the hillside below. Cosy fireplaces and roll top copper bathtubs ensure stays at Lengishu is not only private but homely too.

7 & 8 Borana Conservancy, Laikipia

Spend the next two days exploring Borana.

Game drives, helicopter flights across Northern Kenya, canopy walks at Ngare Ndare Forest, fishing at high altitude lakes, quad biking among herds of wildlife are just some of the exciting activities that guests can get into. Borana Conservancy also has two sets of stables that cater to all riding abilities. From a game room to a petanque pitch, the house offers numerous guest experiences, some at additional cost.
