




Navigating the Aegean

GETTING TO PAROS AND NAXOS





Direct seasonal flights operate from Athens to Paros and Naxos, with a journey time of approximately 45 minutes.

There are also private options available via boat or helicopter from Athens, Mykonos, and Santorini.

As with any Greek island, the best way of reaching Paros and Naxos is to make your way first to Athens, an ancient destination that needs little introduction and deserves a few days exploring itself.

Transcontinental flights arrive and depart from the capital each day and the airport serves as a crucial hub for exploring the many islands of the Aegean Sea.





FINE WINE & SUBLIME FOOD

Discover just how much homemade produce an island can rummage up on a culinary tour that takes in organic family farms making their own olive oil, Parian cheese, and souma

Wine lovers can also

tasting at a Naoussa winery, while more adventurous guests can even take part in a cooking class that gives a fascinating first-hand insight into island cuisine

HIKING ADVENTURES

Contrary to popular opinion, relaxation is not an obligation on the island and those seeking some more active excursions might like to put their hiking boots on and hit the ancient Byzantium Road.

Only a few miles long, the trail from Lefkes to Prodromos is not too strenuous but offers the chance to explore the verdant interior and finish off with a wine and mezze in the village.

FIND THE BEST BEACHES

For many the shallow, emerald waters offer the ideal escapism, especially for those with young families. One of the hidden gems of the island is found at Kastraki beach, offering an unspoilt retreated

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EXPLORING FOOD & CULTURE

produced on the island), distilled for over 100 years in Chalki village.
