This camp will transport them back in time to the era of the **Hemingway safari** with all the **modern luxuries – flushing loos and running water in the bathroom** but preserves some of the best classic safari features such as the **bucket showers and kerosene lanterns**. A stay in A&K's Mobile Camp will ensure that your guests safari is truly unique and will give them unrivalled memories of their time in East Africa.



- Each tent is fully furnished and has its own private veranda.
- The tent is lit by solar lighting which is bright enough to read by.
- Bathrooms have flushing toilets, running water in the sinks and safari bucket showers which are filled by the butler. Dressing gowns and slippers are also provided.
- Laundry will be done during the day and returned in the evening.



- The main area consists of a lounge and dining room with an outside fire place.
- There are charging sockets in the main area for cameras and other equipment.
- Lighting is a mixture of solar and kerosene lanterns.
- All meals, canapes and a wide selection of drinks are included in the rate.



- The camp comes fully staffed with experienced waiters, chefs, tent butlers and guides.
- Use of A&K's 4x4 for game drives.
- There are a number of philanthropy projects that we support across the country which can be included in the itinerary.
- The camp can be put up in Laikipia, Masai Mara, Amboseli and Turkana.

THE GREAT WILDEBEEST MIGRATION

The Great Migration is a never ending cycle that continues throughout the year. It is made up of 1.3M wildebeest and 700,000 zebras that are constantly searching for new grazing and fresh water.

KEY TIMES

January, February & March: The migration is in the Southern Serengeti and the wildebeest give birth to their calves to take advantage of the nutrition rich grass.

April & May: The herds and their calves move west following the rains that roll in across the savannahs.


June & July: The grass is lush and green and this is a time of plenty - the herds move up ino the Grumeti Reserve towards the Masai Mara. This is also the mating season, watch fierce battles between males as the females look on waiting to mate with the strongest.

July & August: The wildebeest and zebra arrive in the Masai Mara and the famous river crossings take place as they battle crocodiles and raging torrents to access the fresh grazing.

September & October: The herds are still in the Mara Reserve and spread out to take advantage of the lush grass. At the end of October they start to cross back into the Northern Serengeti.

November: November is the start of the second (short) rains in East Africa and the herds move down through the Eastern Corridor to reach their birthing territory in the Southern Serengeti.

December: December is an easy time, plenty of fresh grazing and water.


In addition to owning these vehicles we also have our **own workshops and mechanics** to ensure they are properly maintained for your guests safaris.




WHEN TO TRAVEL





A&K'S INSIDER TIPS


Rwanda has several lovely little parks that make for a great circuit - if you book a circuit for your guests the cost of the gorilla permits also decreases. Combining Rwanda and Tanzania is very easy with a flight that connects Kigali and the Serengeti via Mwanza. Guests can also drive across the border to Uganda and experience gorilla tracking in both countries.

when there is little vegetation and the wildlife congregates around the water sources.


CAPE TOWN



A&K'S INSIDER TIPS

Victoria Falls reaches its peak flood in April and May and carry's on until September - guests should pack a waterproof case for their cameras! In October the falls could dry up on the Zambian side, we suggest booking a tour of the Falls on the Zimbabwean side this time of the year. The South Luangwa is a journey back in time and the home of the walking safari.



Victoria Falls remains the main attraction in the area however the area **also offers a variety of other** activities including sundowner cruises and scenic helicopter flights. National parks like Hwange and Mana Pools also offer incredible game viewing.
