




EGYPT, LAND OF THE PHARAOHS

CAIRO

The city was also the cosmopolitan hub and premier learning center in ancient times. Now a vibrant, bustling city, visitors can enjoy the relics of the ancient world, as well as any one of the myriad exquisite fish restaurants that the city is famous for and it's bustling, jovial nightlife.

LUXOR


Filled with awe inspiring monuments of ancient civilization as well as some of the best preserved relics, Luxor is considered the world's largest open air museum and home to one third of the world's antiquities making it one of the main tourist attractions in Egypt. Luxor is the modern name for Thebes, ancient capital city of the New Kingdom Pharaohs (1550 BC - 1070 BC) whose glory still glowed in the memories of classical writers a thousand years after its decline. Here the booty of foreign wars, tributes and taxes poured into the coffers of the 18th and 19th dynasty Pharaohs, each of whom surpassed his predecessor in the construction of incredible temples and tombs, creating a concentration of monuments that rivals that of any imperial city before or since.

The town has a village atmosphere and a bustling local market, and one of the most pleasant ways to get around town is by the «caleches», or two-person horse carriages, that run along the Corniche.

ASWAN

Lying at the southernmost border of Egypt's ancient empire, Aswan is truly the «Jewel of the Nile». Pink and grey granite thrusts upward through the Nubian sandstone, forming mountains, cliffs and jagged outcroppings.

Aswan is home to the Aswan High Dam, where the Nile's flow is regulated for the whole of Egypt.



The area was formerly known in ancient times as Nubia, and has its own unique heritage, crafts and folklore. The Nubian language is still spoken today by many Aswan residents, and traditional Nubian folkloric performances are a must-see for any visitor. Several sites of outstanding world heritage were actually moved piece by piece to higher ground before the dam was made operational - including the romantically elegant Temple of Philae in Aswan itself, and the incredible temples of Abu Simbel to the south.

Aswan offers a wonderful opportunity to simply relax and enjoy the beautiful scenery and timeless ambience of Egypt.

ST. CATHERINE'S MONASTERY

A major highlight is St. Catherine's Monastery in the foothills of Mount Moses, in the heart of the Sinai. St Catherine's Monastery was constructed by order of the Emperor Justinian between 527 AD and 565 AD, and is one of the oldest continuously inhabited monasteries in the world. The central chapel is dedicated to St. Catherine, the legendary martyr of Alexandria, who was tortured for her faith. The monastery's spiritual heart is the Chapel of the Burning Bush, an unassuming structure of tremendous religious significance. According to the oldest monastic tradition, this chapel sits atop the roots of the same Biblical bush that burned when God spoke to Moses for the first time.

HURGHADA

Hurghada is perfect for travelers wanting to vacation in paradise whilst experiencing a generous slice of authenticity. The only Red Sea destination that encompasses beach-like beauty within a large, thriving city, Hurghada offers the best of both worlds.

It is considered one of the leading tourist resorts of the Red Sea coast and an international center for aquatic sports, windsurfing, sailing, deep-sea fishing, swimming, but, above all, snorkeling and diving. The unique underwater lifeforms are some of the finest in the world, justifiably famous amongst divers. The warm waters here are ideal for many varieties of rare fish and coral reefs, which may also be observed through glass bottom boats.
